












OUR VALUES

WANDA IN FULL PRODUCTION












Wanda is a project that Talleres has been supporting since the first day by providing our engineers who have been involved since the design stage. At the same time, at our workshop we fabricated the floating pontoon and on the engineering area, the accessories were developed. As far as now, we are so proud to know this trash collector is accomplishing its mission. Last month Wanda collected 2500 pounds of plastics in 5 days.

Wanda is an innovative system which also represents the first of its kind in Latin America. It uses hydraulic energy and solar panels to collect and remove solid waste that floats in the river, preventing it from reaching the sea. The Wanda system functions with state-of-the-art technology that takes into account all the necessary considerations to operate in conditions that improve the quality of life of the residents adjoining the project and guarantees sustainability and harmony with the environment. Talleres will keep working and supporting Marea Verde and all good actions driving to a better world for generations to come.





WORKING IN THE SKIES

Talleres has been performing scaffolding tasks on a day-to-day basis from minor jobs on deck or our workshops; to complex projects on ships cranes, ships sides, ballast, and cargo tanks, lay berths.

Basically, our scaffolding works for ship repairs and maintenance cover the whole vessel, including underwater jobs.

We are capable of installing different types of scaffolding of any shape and any size depending on the situation.

For example, Hanging Scaffolds are installed on ships sides for structural repairs, renaming of vessels.

Hanging Scaffolds can also be installed on cranes jobs and inside tanks.

Tubular scaffolding is installed when you have a solid and secure platform which you can build upon to reach heights, plus job is accompanied by good weather (no rolling of the vessel).



CRANE BARGE SERVICES




Talleres Crane Barge has been working at Balboa anchorage nonstop in several projects with a goal to expedite solutions and accomplish turnkey projects 24/7.


Some of the most common jobs which Talleres could assist with are:

INSTALLATION OF BALLAST WATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM





We can get involved in any phase of the ballast system installation project and add value to the task of makers and ship owners. In addition, we can offer from the 3D scan modeling process for feasibility studies or participate on the turnkey installation along with OEM.





At the end of 2022, we participated in two projects simultaneously, one tanker was done at Balboa lay berth and one bulk carrier was done during voyage. We performed on both prefabrication of the piping system and auxiliary elements, electrical jobs and connections, and installation of the ballast water system onboard the ship. Both projects were successfully completed.



ANCHOR CHAIN REPLACEMENT & REPAIRS





Loose and damaged Anchor Chain Studs is becoming a more frequent issue for ship managers, not to mention the pain of losing or damaging an anchor and accessories during maneuvering due to structural failure of her windlass motor, windlass brakes, chain stoppers as well as failure on anchor shackles, swivels, chain, or due to dragging on bad weather.
