


Juvencio Pizza is his name and that is the name of our new boat which makes us feel very proud because under that name are the values of Talleres Industriales.

#### **24/7 MAIN ENGINE REPAIRS**



At Talleres Industriales, we perform daily mechanical jobs that include Main Auxiliary Engine, Engine, and turbochargers overhaul, propulsion systems, rudder steering gears, all types of cranes and hydraulic systems overhaul and repairs, rigging jobs, and auxiliary engines maintenance. Our mechanical department is represented by a dedicated team of almost 60 skilled mechanics and service engineers with vast experience who are ready to assist vour vessel to ensure we meet our client's demands: we continuously invest in resources and equipment with the highest standards.

Recent department investments have included fifty-ton pneumatic chain blocks, air compressors, line boring machines, and laser alignment equipment.



Moreover, we have supply boats as well as deck and crane barges available on both sides of the Panama Canal, which are required for different types of jobs. Regardless of the job's complexity, our mechanics face each project with the same level of importance and intensity working on a 24-hour basis to ensure that we exceed our clients' requirements and expectations.







# STRUCTURAL REPAIRS AT CRISTOBAL ANCHORAGE



Last month, a Panamax oil chemical tanker suffered a collision during her northbound transit at the Panama Canal. Due to the heavy contact on her port side shell plate, the plate and internal structural members were ruptured and buckled.


Engineers and Welding Foreman from Talleres Industriales, S.A. attended the vessel at Cristobal Inner Anchorage along with ABS class surveyor and insurance surveyor to perform a detailed damage assessment.





Upon completion of all structural surveys and reviewing all drawings, Talleres managed to submit a repair plan with all needed certificates of our personnel and material to vessel owners for a permanent repair.





Talleres was assigned to perform the job and all resources were arranged to attend 24/7 and avoid further commercial losses. During the inspection Talleres found the structural damages on Port side Water Ballast Tank no.1 from Frame 80 to Frame 82 in way of stringer No 3.

Around 5 meters by 4 meter of 15.8 mm in thickness of shell plate grade A was cropped and renewed.





Also, web frames 81 and 82, which were heavily damaged, had to be renewed along with affected longitudinal, steel brackets, and stiffeners.






As usual, we made the anchorage our playing field and executed the job while vessel was afloat.

Job was performed on a 24/7 basis with full support of our supply boats with crane and crew boats. All jobs needed to be performed following IACS recommendations and as per class satisfaction.

#### **SCRUBBER PIPE RENEWAL**



Last month we received an inquiry from one of our loyal clients requesting from us to replace a scrubber overboard pipe that was leaking.






Many vessels face this issue due to the high sulfur content on the scrubber wash water, which is used to clean the fuel emissions to comply with International Maritime Organization (IMO) 2020 sulfur oxide emissions. Acidic water can create corrosion which results in a leak in the pipe, like in this case.



This type of repair is usually done during dry-dock, however, Talleres has all the required qualified personnel, certifications, and resources to perform it afloat. This permanent solution avoids the need to use a more expensive cleaner alternative fuel to comply with the environmental regulations until the next scheduled dry-dock.



In this case, a cofferdam was required because it was not possible to trim the vessel enough to meet our safety standards. Therefore, the first step was to take the cofferdam template and fabricate it. Secondly, the divers proceed to install the cofferdam, which is a task they perform quite often.

After the cofferdam is secured and a dry environment is guaranteed, our certified welders start cropping the affected area. Then, the workshop team fit and weld the new pipe section following class standards and procedures. As a class requirement, an NDT technician performed liquid and Ultrasonic tests. Since internal painting treatment plays a very important role in extending the pipe lifespan, we removed the valve and adjacent elbow to allow the crew to paint the pipe internally.



After the paint curina time class-approved welding was completed, divers proceeded to remove the cofferdam. Finally, the system was started, and the crew inspected that no leak was present. repairs were executed as class per requirements.
